D'varim - דברים August 13, 2016 – 9 Av 5776 Shabbat Hazon - אבת חזון Erev Tisha B'Av

This Shabbat we begin the reading of the fifth book of the Torah—D'varim. The first portion, D'varim, is always read on the Shabbat before Tisha B'Av, which we will be observing starting this Saturday night into Sunday.

The book of D'varim contains long speeches given by Moses just before he dies, while the people are about to enter the Promised Land. He reviews important events of the past forty years and blames the people for the forty-year delay in getting to the Promised Land, mainly because they were misled by the ten spies and lost their faith in God. He urges them to keep the Torah and teach it to future generations.

This Shabbat is also known as Shabbat Hazon, from the first word of the Haftarah that is read on the Shabbat before Tisha B'Av. It is the first chapter of the Book of Isaiah. Isaiah condemns the society in which he lives because of the widespread corruption and infidelity to God. In his reproof, he asks "eicha" - how did the City (Zion), which was the seat of justice and righteousness, turn to a base of thieves and murderers? This kind of reflection is appropriate as we prepare to observe Tisha B'Av, the saddest day on the Jewish Calendar.

This Day in Jewish History—9 Av



In 586 BCE, the first Holy Temple was destroyed by fire, as Nebuchadnezzar's Babylonian troops conquered Jerusalem. Also on this day, the second Temple was destroyed by the Romans in 70 CE. Tisha B'Av

has long been a day of calamity for the Jewish people: On this day, during the time of Moses, Jews in the desert accepted the slanderous report of the spies, resulting in the decree postponing entry into the Land of Israel. Other grave misfortunes throughout Jewish history occurred on the Ninth of Av: The Spanish Inquisition culminated with the expulsion of Jews from Spain on Tisha B'Av in 1492. World War I broke out on the eve of Tisha B'Av in 1914 when Germany declared war on Russia: German resentment from the war set the stage for the Holocaust. On the eve of Tisha B'Av 1942, the mass deportation began of Jews from the Warsaw Ghetto, en route to Treblinka. Today, Tisha B'Av is the Jewish national day of mourning, when we don't eat, drink or bathe. Lights in the synagogue are dimmed, and we read the Book of Lamentations, Jeremiah's poetic lament over the destruction of Jerusalem.
