Beshalah (Exodus Chapters 13-17) **Shabbat Shirah**

Pages 265-280 - Haftarah Judges IV-, 4— 5V , 31

January 23-29, 2016 13 –19 Shevat, 5776

This Shabbat we read the portion of Beshalah. This Shabbat is also known as Shabbat Shirah, the Shabbat of the song, because this Parasha contains the Song that Moses and the Children of Israel sang upon crossing the Sea of Reed.

In addition to the description of the parting of the sea, this Parasha also includes the story of the Manna that will be their food for the next forty years. One of the qualities of the Manna is that you could prepare it in any way you wish. For some it was wonderful as you could pretend that it is one of your favorite food, and it would feel and taste like that food. For others it was too boring having the same thing, day after day. In the course of their journey , they will complain that it is dry and rotten. Like everything in life, some people think they got a lemon, while others make lemonade and are very happy with it.
