**א' דראש חדש תמוז—Rosh Hodesh Tammuz**

In this week's Parasha we read of a rebellion against Moses' leadership. Korah, a cousin of Moses, accuses Moses and Aaron of taking too much power for themselves. Moses being the leader and Aaron being the High Priest does not leave much for anyone else.

Korah claims that Moses could have picked anyone from the community as the entire congregation is holy. Moses defends himself by saying that God chose Aaron. However, if Korah and the 250 individuals who are siding with him feel that they could serve in the Temple, they should each bring incense burners and stand before the Temple, and God will choose the right person for the job. This rebellion ends with Korah being swallowed by the ground and all 250 followers dying in a fire.

## This Day in Jewish History—30 Sivan

On June 30, 1927, Henry Ford issued an "apology" for publishing excerpts from the *Protocols of the Elders of Zion* in his newspaper, *Dearborn Independent*. *Protocols* is an anti-Semitic forgery purporting to be the conspiratorial discussions of the Jewish elders plotting to take over the world. Thanks in large part to Ford, *Protocols* was -- next to the Bible -- the best-selling book in the world during the 1920s. The *Independent* also published, in Ford's name, several anti-Jewish articles; these were published in the 1920s as a 4-volume set entitled, *The International Jew, the World's Foremost Problem*. These books were distributed through Ford's car dealerships. Prior to World War II, Ford lavished praise on Adolf Hitler and the Nazi philosophy, and there is evidence that Ford gave Hitler direct financial backing. In 1938, Ford was awarded (and accepted) the Grand Cross of the Order of the German Eagle, Nazi Germany's highest honorary award given to foreigners. Even today, Ford's writings are used as propaganda by neo-Nazi groups.
